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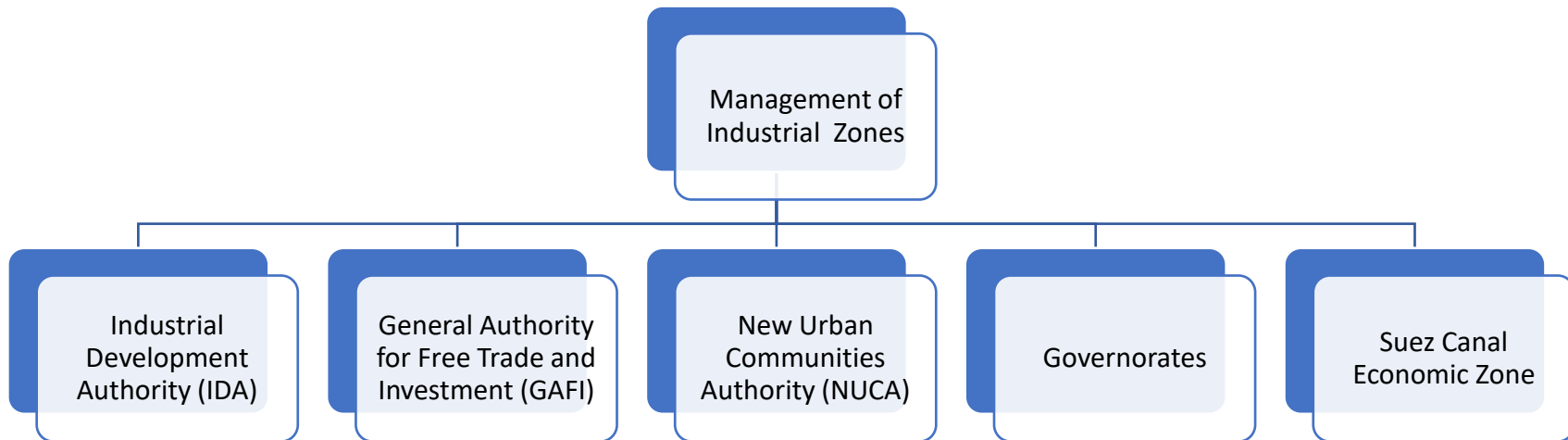

There are currently 147 industrial zones (or industrial parks) in Egypt, which vary greatly in scale, characteristics, and **governance structure**.

- In-depth baseline analysis (focus groups/surveys and one-to-one interviews)

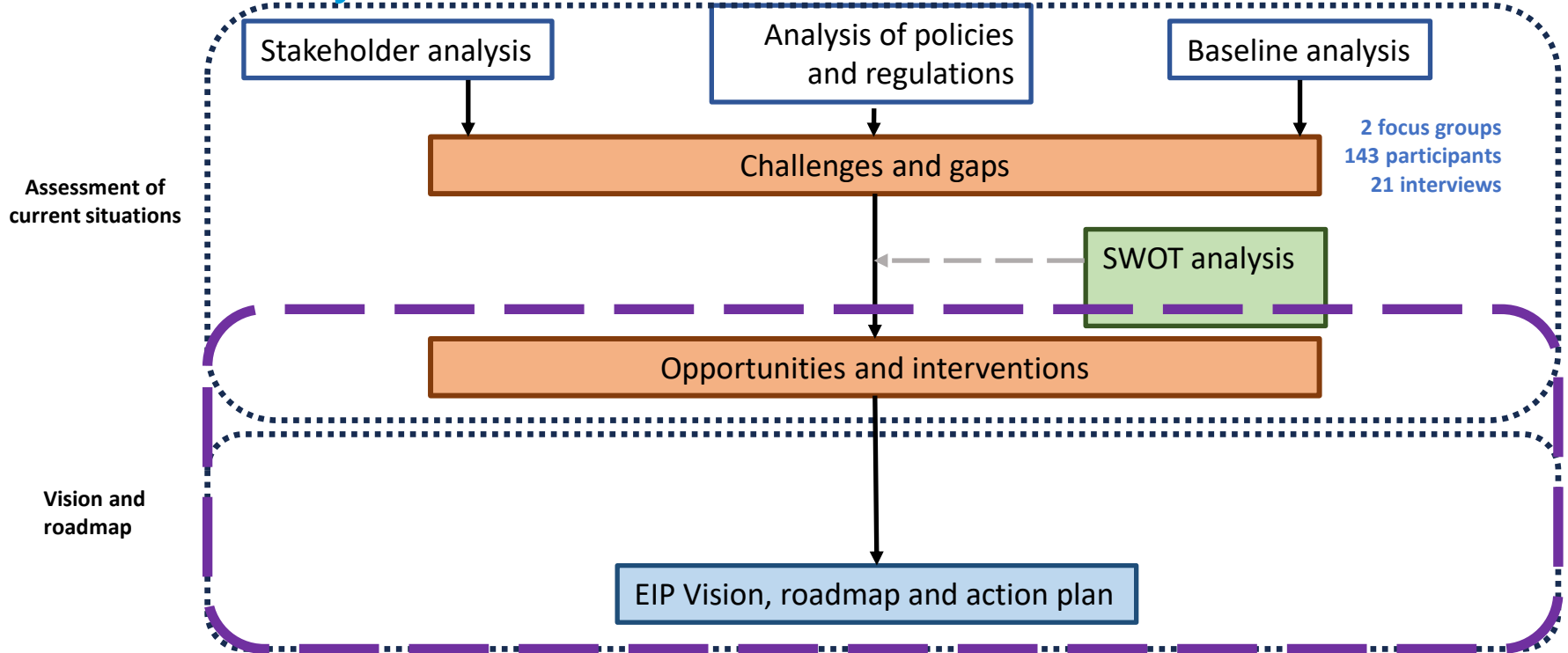
## Capacity building

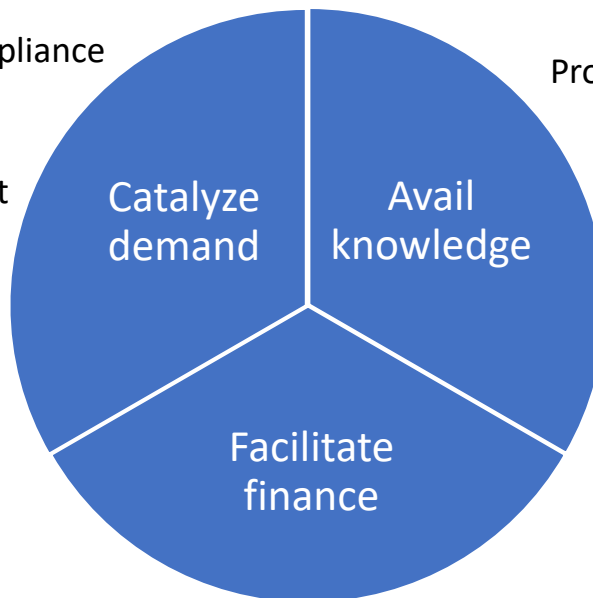

## EIP Roadmap Co-ordination Committee

It is suggested that an overarching coordination committee is formed in collaboration with the SCZONE, NUCA, GAFI and UNIDO and chaired by the IDA , for the implementation of and follow-up on the EIP roadmap action plan.
